

TOWN OF OAK GROVE COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 5, 2010

The Oak Grove Town Council of the Town of Oak Grove, Arkansas met for its regular monthly meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Morgan and a quorum was established.

On roll call the following were present, Alderman Gary High, Alderwoman Janice McKelvey, Alderman Eugene Reynolds and Alderman Sam Jones. Alderman Josh Peden was absent.

The minutes for September 7 were read. There being no corrections or alterations, Mayor Morgan asked for a motion. Alderwoman Janice McKelvey, seconded by Alderman Eugene Reynolds moved to accept the minutes as read. All members voted in the affirmative.

The minutes for the meeting of September 17 were read. There being no corrections or alterations, Mayor Morgan asked for a motion. Alderman Eugene Reynolds, seconded by Alderman Gary High, moved to accept the minutes as read. All members voted in the affirmative and the minutes were approved.

The first order of business was the presentation of the bills. The bills were checked and initialed by the Council. Alderman Sam Jones, seconded by Alderwoman Janice McKelvey, moved to allocate money to pay the bills. All voted in the affirmative.

Mayor Morgan read Ordinance #82-2010 in full. Alderman Gary High seconded by Alderman Sam Jones made a motion to accept. All voted in the affirmative. Mayor Morgan read Ordinance #82-2010, the second time by title only. Alderman Eugene Reynolds, seconded by Alderwoman Janice McKelvey, moved to accept. All voted in the affirmative. Mayor Morgan read Ordinance #82-2010 the third time by title only. Alderwoman Janice McKelvey, seconded by Eugene Reynolds moved to accept. All voted in the affirmative.


New business; Gordon White and Joe Bill Snowden, representatives with American Rabbit Hounds, were present to ask permission to use the Community Building for their meetings. The Council agreed to \$25.00 per month, keep it clean and winterize the bathrooms (winter hours) after each meeting. Alderman Sam Jones, seconded by Alderman Gary High, moved to accept. All voted in the affirmative.

Mike McKelvey from the Fire Dept. asked for permission to purchase a projector. The Town can also use the projector if needed. Alderman Sam Jones, seconded by Alderman Gary High made a motion for the general fund to purchase the projector. All voted in the affirmative.

The Council discussed water Superintendent, Rodney Newman, using the Water vehicle for personal use. It was agreed by all that he cannot. He is to keep a log book, with his mileage, to and from the locations, name of locations and copy of gas used.

The final item was the motion to adjourn. Alderman Sam Jones, seconded by Gary High moved to adjourn. All voted in the affirmative.
