Alderman Eugene Reynolds, seconded by Gary Gray made a motion to pay Josh Brandt and Kyle McKelvey \$10.00 each for picking up the Christmas lights and storing them. All voted in the affirmative.

The final item was the motion to adjourn. Alderman Gary Gray, seconded by Eugene Reynolds. All voted in the affirmative.
