TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

The Town Council of the Town of Oak Grove met for a regular meeting, June 3rd in the town hall. On roll call the following were present, Alderwoman Leah Morgan, Aldermen Eugene Reynolds, Sam VanDiver, Gary High, and Mark Nance.

In the absence of Mayor Peden, Recorder Pat Carlton filled in for Mayor Peden.

The meeting was called to order and a quorum was established.

The first order of business was the reading of May minutes, Alderman Gary High, seconded by Alderman Eugene Reynolds, made a motion to accept the minutes as read. All voted in the affirmative. The special called meeting of May 19 were read. Alderman Mark Nance seconded by Alderman Gary High made a motion to accept the minutes. All voted in the affirmative.

The second order of business was the paying the bills. The bills were checked and initialed by the Council. Alderman Sam VanDiver seconded by Alderman Gary High made a motion to allocate money to pay the bills, all voted in the affirmative.

The third order of business was the discussion of winter propane. Alderman Gary High, seconded by Alderman Eugene Reynolds, made a motion to use George's gas co. All voted in the affirmative.

The fourth order of business. The agreement for the use of the Arena as a Go-Cart race track, from Dawn Allen, was read and discussed. Alderman Gary High, seconded by Alderwoman Leah Morgan made a motion to accept. All voted in the affirmative.

The fifth order of business was water rates for hauled water for pools and etc. After discussion, Alderwoman Leah Morgan, seconded by Alderman Mark Nance made a motion for water hauled in town limits charge \$50.00 per load. Outside, but within the fire district, charge \$60.00. All voted in the affirmative.

The next order of business, Police Chief Jason Hunt discussed grants available to the town for the Police Dept. He talked about the donated dog that is offered to the Dept. The dog is in San Antonio, TX. And he will have to make a trip to get it. Alderman Sam VanDiver, seconded by Alderman Mark Nance, made a motion to reimburse Jason for the trip. All voted in the affirmative.

The last order of business, Alderman Mark Nance, seconded by Alderwoman Leah Morgan, made a motion to adjourn. All voted in the affirmative.
