TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
MARCH 4, 2014

The Town Council of the Town of Oak Grove, Ar. Met March 4th in the Town Hall for a regular monthly meeting. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Josh Peden and a quorum was established. On roll call the following were present, Aldermen Eugene Reynolds, Gary High, Sam Van Diver and Mark Nance. Alderwoman Leah Morgan was absent.

The first order of business was the reading of February minutes. Alderman Eugene Reynolds seconded by Alderman Gary High made a motion to accept the minutes as read. All voted in the affirmative.

The second order of business was the presentation of the bills. The bills were checked and initialed by the Council. Alderman Eugene Reynolds seconded by Alderman Mark Nance made a motion to allocate money to pay the bills. All voted in the affirmative.

The Police Chief's salary has to be increased by \$200.00 to a total of \$16,200.00 annually.

Mayor Peden talked to the Council about hiring Jerrod Newberry as the Reserve Officer of Oak Grove. Alderman Gary High seconded by Alderman Sam Van Diver made a motion to accept. All voted in the affirmative.

Gary High seconded by Sam Van Diver made a motion to accept Jerrod Newberry as Police Reserve Officer. All voted in the affirmative.
Jerrod Newberry was sworn in as Police Reserve Officer for the Town of Oak Grove by Mayor Josh Peden.

The last order of business, Alderman Eugene Reynolds seconded by Alderman Sam Van Diver made a motion to adjourn. All voted in the affirmative.
