No one has put in a bid to put the septic tank in at the Town Hall. Mayor Peden said he would call Philip Greer and then would call each of the Council to see if they agree to the cost and installation.

The fifth order of business, Alderwoman Leah Morgan seconded by Jackie Powers made a motion to enter in the agreement that Judge Kent Crow gave the Council, to become the City Attorney. All voted in the affirmative.


