TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

Jan 5, 2016

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OAK GROVE MET FOR A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING JAN. 5, 2016 IN THE TOWN HALL. MAYOR PEDEN CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER AND A QUORUM WAS ESTABLISHED.

ON ROLL CALL THE FOLLING WERE PRESENT, ALDERWOMEN SABRINA NANCE, LEAH MORGAN AND JACKIE POWERS. ALDERMEN EUGENE REYNOLDS AND GUS WANDREY.

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE READING OF DEC. MINUTES. ALDERWOMAN JACKIE POWERS SECONDED BY ALDERMAN EUGENE REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS READ. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

THE THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BILLS. THE BILLS WERE CHECKED AND INITIALED BY THE COUNCIL. ALDERWOMAN SABRINA NANCE SECONDED BY ALDERWOMAN LEAH MORGAN MADE A MOTION TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO PAY THE BILLS. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS. MAYOR PEDEN TALKED TO JUDGE CROW ABOUT WRITING UP TWO ORDIANCES. MAYOR PEDEN THEN READ THE ORDIANCES #93-2016 PROHIBITING ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE. AND ARE DECLARED TO BE A NUSIANCE. THIS DECLARED BY ARKANSAS CODE 13-54-1101. THE MAYOR READ THE ORDIANCE FOR THE FIRST TIME. JUDGE CROW SAID MOST OF OUR ORDINANCES NEED TO BE RE WRITTEN. THE COUNCIL WAS IN AGREEMENT TO HAVE HIM DO THEM.

MAYOR PEDEN TOLD THE COUNCIL THAT THE STOP LIGHTS NEED TO BE REPLACED. NO RESPONSE.

MAYOR PEDEN TAKLED TO THE COUNCIL ABOUT REMOVING THE LARGE LEANING OAK TREE IN FRONT OF THE TOWN HALL. TWO BIDS WERE TURNED IN. FANNING TREE SERVICE BID WAS 725.00. GREG EASTER WAS GIVEN PERMISSION TO TRIM BRUSH ON THE EAST SIDE OF CR 4351.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS THE PRESENTATION OF THE BUDGET. ALDERWOMAM LEAH MORÇAN SECONDED BY ALDERWOMAN JACKIE POWERS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT. ALL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.

THE LAST ORDER OF BUSINESS, ALDERWOMAN LEAH MORGAN SECONDED BY ALDERWOMAN JACKIE POWERS MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. ALL COUNCIL VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE.
