

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

September 5, 2017

Mayor Pat Carlton called meeting to order at 7:00 pm. She ask all present to stand for the pledge allegiance.

Council present : Jackie Powers, Eugene Reynolds, Leah Morgan, Gary Gray and Gus Wandrey. Linda Wandrey acting recorder.

Minutes were read from August 1, 2017 meeting. Jackie Powers made motion to accept minutes second by Eugene Reynolds all agreed.

Monthly balance sheet and bills were presented. Eugene Reynolds made motion to accept balance sheet and pay bills second by Gus Wandrey all agreed.

Ambulance commission was to be here to speak about the new ambulance service in the county but no one present. Mike McKelvey spoke with someone on the phone and they are to set another date to address council.

The 5 mill tax was presented. Leah Morgan made motion to accept and have filed as needed second by Eugene Reynolds all agreed.

A bid had been turned in on a new heat and air unit but council wants to go ahead with decision from last months meeting and get a ventless heater and window air unit.

Concerns with the budget in the water department was presented, needing to raise the water rates were discussed and council tabled the issue till next months meeting. Looking for other options other than rate increase.

Leah Morgan had a concern of customers having water leaks and when the meters are read that nothing is being said or noted so they can be contacted. Council agreed that a note should be added to the meter sheets if customers are not contacted at their homes and secretary contact customers if at all possible when there are high meter readings.


State Health Department had called and the food shack at the ball park can not be used until they can inspect the building that it has not been inspected in two years.


The Carroll County clean up will be done on the second Sat of October (the 14th) Flyers will be posted in various parts of town.
