

**Oak Grove, AR**  
**City Council Meeting**

April 2, 2019

- Mayor Dwane Malotte called to order the meeting of the Oak Grove City Council at 7:00 PM April 2nd at Oak Grove City Hall. He asked all present to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Storm siren was tested at 7pm
- Council members present were Jackie Powers, Eugene Reynolds, Terry Hutchison, & Gary Gray. Also Present: Rhonda Brantner recorder. Council member Jayme Wambold absent.
- Rhonda Brantner read the minutes for the March council meeting. Gary Gray made the motion to accept the minutes as read, second by Jackie Powers. All agreed and minutes for March 2019 minutes were approved as read.
- Monthly bills were presented. Eugene Reynolds made the motion to pay bills, second by Jackie Powers, all agreed.
- Gary Gray made the motion to approve the yearly financial statement for January through December 2018, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Eugene Reynolds, all agreed.
- County Road 614, County Road 4351 and Parakeet Ln are set to begin maintenance with the next few weeks.
- \$13275.00 was transferred from the General Fund to Lopfi to catch up the past amount owed, dating back to the year of 2009 for the retirement funds of four Oak Grove firefighters.
- Due to the water tank project on schedule for April 11th, 2019 a boil order could be in affect for 7-10 days beginning on the 11<sup>th</sup> of April. Also, Rodney Newman is checking into the cost of converting from Chlorine gas to Chlorine liquid.
- Already purchased speed limit signs need to be installed on County Road 433, Mayor Malotte will talk to the County Road foreman to see if they can help with installing them.
- Fire Chief Steve Allen told council that he had been approached with an offer from a landowner wanting to donate a ½ acre on Hwy 311 to the Oak Grove Fire Dept. for a substation to be built on that property. Steve thought it would be a good idea to offer

a small sum of money and to help cover the land owners cost that he would be out for transfer of title and deed to the property. Gary Gray made the motion to pursue the Hwy 311 acreage and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Terry Hutchison. All Agreed.

- Gary Gray made the motion to adjourn at 8:10 pm, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Terry Hutchison.
