



## Oak Grove Town Council Meeting Minutes November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020

- \* Meeting called to order at 7:05pm. All present asked to stand for pledge allegiance
- \* Council members present Gary Gray, Jayme Wambold, Jackie Powers and Stephanie Shepherd (Recorder) ABSNET: Terry Hutchison
- \* Council Minutes for OCTOBER 2020 read aloud by Stephanie Shepherd
  - o Motion made to accept minutes by Jayme Wambold; seconded Jackie Powers - All Agreed
- \* Present Monthly Bills paid in OCTOBER 2020
  - o Motion made to pay bills Gary Gray; seconded Jayme Wambold – All Agreed
- \* Reviewed Account Balance Sheets – SEPTEMBER & OCTOBER 2020
- \* Rural Community Grant – Project Underway
  - o Walking Trail – Completed - Council discussed large dirt pile left from walking trail construction. Stephanie Shepherd to contact Greer Excavating about whose to remove pile.
  - o Security Camera System previously discussed by Council – No Update Yet
  - o Grant Funds have been exhausted. Stephanie Shepherd to contact Jeremy Ragland about final report for Grant Funds that were spent.
- \* State Aid Street Committee assistance request for funding addition street signs and the repaving of CR 674 and 614; other roads for consideration include CR 433, 618, and 616. Gary Gray informed council that there was no more money currently. Council to pursue again in the future. Also, Council approved applying for next street grant.
- \* Letter concerning Unsightly property at 11898 HWY 21 North, was sent Sept 16, 2020
  - o Mr. Bowen has contacted Stephanie Shepherd and is now aware of the issue. He will be in the area in November and will work to have the property looking better soon.
- \* No further information from Attorney regarding future Ordinances & Resolutions discussed last month. Stephanie Shepherd to contact regarding update.
- \* Water Dept Audits for 2018 and 2019 from Killingsworth
  - o Stephanie Shepherd spoke with David Killingsworth on 11/10/2020. Was assured that 2018 and 2019 Audits will be finished by the end December making current by end of this year. Requested that 2020 information be ready for review at end of January 2021 to begin on immediately.
  - o To confirm meeting this week to discuss preliminary audit findings and provide any other information to firm.

### FIRE DEPARTMENT –

- \* Fire Chief Steve Allen updates Council on Siren issues discussed last meeting. Siren had blown breaker. Asst. Chief Mike McKelvey replaced bad breakers and checked batteries. Siren has been tested and is now much louder than before. Council discussed with Chief about having a monthly maintenance/audit of the siren to monitor performance.
- \* Fire Dept, with Council approval, had bid on a Tanker auctioned last week out of Missouri. Unfortunately, the bidding exceeded our budget for a new tanker. The Fire Dept will continue to look for a Tanker suitable to add to our local department.
- \* Council Member makes motion to adjourn by Jackie Powers; seconded by Jayme Wambold – All Agreed
