



Town of Oak Grove, AR
Town Council Meeting Minutes
May 4th, 2021

- ❖ Mayor Dwane Malotte called to order the regular meeting of the Oak Grove Town Council at 7:02pm at the Oak Grove Town Hall. All present asked to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- ❖ Council Members present Jayme Wambold, Jackie Powers, Gary Gray, C. Elbert Standlee, and Terry Hutchison
- ❖ Stephanie Shepherd read the minutes from the APRIL 2021 meeting. Jayme Wambold made motion to accept minutes, seconded by Jackie Powers. All Agreed.
- ❖ Oath of Office administered by Mayor Dwane Malotte for Alderman Position #4 – C. Elbert Standlee, witnessed by Council and others present.
- ❖ Monthly Bills for APRIL 2021 were presented. Motion made by Jayme Wambold to pay bills, seconded Jackie Powers. All Agreed.
- ❖ Preliminary APRIL 2021 Financial Balance Sheet presented to Council – Bank statements not yet received.
- ❖ Update on Ordinance regarding Code Enforcer.
 - Mayor Malotte spoke with David Ore (current GF Code Enforcer) and he is not interested in the position but willing to help train the person selected.
 - Still need to speak with prosecuting attorney to see if we can even more forward with creating position.
- ❖ School House (Community Building) Repairs – estimates reviewed by Council.
 - Gary Gray made motion to accept proposal from Mr. Dickenson, seconded by Elbert Standlee, All Agreed; and Randall Dickenson was approved by Council with estimate and plan for repairs discussed and presented for roof. Project would take approximately 3 days, but he will have to work it into is current schedule (unable to give a start date).
 - Council discussed purchase of picnic tables and trashcans for park area. Gary Gray made motion to purchase, seconded by Terry Hutchison; All Agreed. Council approved Stephanie Shepherd to order/purchase 4 picnic tables and 2 metal trashcans.
 - Council discussed the need to close in the corral around park. Bruce MaCall was suggested as possibility. Terry Hutchison to call about interest in job and costs.
